- The minimum balance required to open a Savings account is \$50.00.
- The average daily balance of a Savings account must exceed \$10.00 during a calendar quarter to earn any interest.
- The minimum balance required to open a SUPERNOW account or a MMDA account is \$200.00.
- The average daily balance of a SUPERNOW or a MMDA account must exceed \$500.00 during a month to earn any interest.
- Interest is calculated on the average daily collected balance for non-time deposit accounts. The APY for SUPER NOW, MMDA, and Savings deposits assumes monthly compounding. Withdrawal of accumulated interest will reduce future earnings. Fees could reduce earnings. Rates are subject to change after account opening.
